ctober is always a special month in the Church's calendar as we set time aside for devotion to our Blessed Mother, giving her praise for her readiness to be such a huge part in the story of our salvation, and also turning to her in prayer and petition as we pray not only for ourselves but for those we know, love and especially those who need God's help in life. It's a well-known fact that it's very hard for any son to refuse what his mother asks, and if that's true for us, then it's true too for Christ Himself, and this month we pray that God, through the intercession Mary may help us all with the right answer to our prayers, that He may bless us in the way best for us and those we love. In that vein, next Saturday we hold our Parish Mass for the Sick and those who care for them, when all those who are sick in any way are invited to receive the Sacrament of the Sick and all carers are invited to receive a blessing to help their in their work. Everyone is invited to come along to this Mass, regardless of what Parish you belong to, and you alone know if you need or would like the Anointing of the Sick – no one will ask you why you need it, because that is between you and God. Devotions will be held in St Mary and St Joseph's Church each Sunday evening at 6.00pm – please feel welcome to join for this brief service. This month as a Parish we will certainly try to mark our Marian devotion - but maybe this month we could all try to say one extra prayer a day at home or in our private lives too - and if we don't need it for ourselves, offer it up for whoever does need it and maybe some little grace will come from our efforts. This month, give praise to the holy Virgin Mary, for the sun of justice, our hope and our saving, was born from her.
